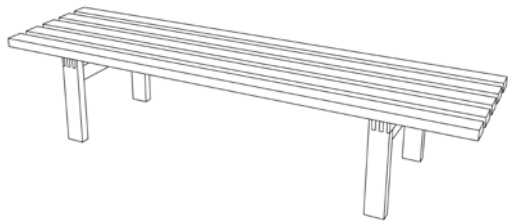

Dimensions:

160/200 x 42 (5 laths)/60 (7 laths) x 30/40 cm WxDxH



Material:

Solid ash with a transparent varnish or black stained.
Solid wenge wood with a transparent varnish.

Designed in 1960 by Martin Visser at request of the Dutch Stedelijk Museum Amsterdam where the BZ is still in use today. The design was received so well by the public that Visser added several variations and dimensions of the bench to Spectrums collection in 1965.

The simple but beautiful tooth connections of the wood are characteristic for this bench. Sizes and material are still the same as in the 1965 version. Also a little pillow of 42x60 cm is available, suitable for all benches.
